<b>Content:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Introduction to OAR</li><li>• Introduction to rowing theory, nomenclature and equipment</li><li>• Rowing safety including technique practice on rowing ergometer and boat flip test</li><li>• Demonstrate ability to float/tread water for 10 minutes</li></ul>
<b>Day 2:</b>	<b>Morning Session – 9:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. (Saturday, except Sunday June 6th)</b>
<b>Location:</b>	<b>Swantown Marina, OAR boathouse and dock</b>
<b>Content:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Rowing technique practice on land</li><li>• Rowing technique practice on the water (in single and/or double boats)</li><li>• Continual practice with safety precautions</li><li>• Introduction, modeling, and practicing of rowing technique drills and workouts for beginners</li><li>• Final session will include an informal “test” to ensure you are prepared to begin rowing safely on your own!</li></ul>
<b>Days 3-4:</b>	<b>Evening Sessions – beginning at 5:30 p.m. (Monday &amp; Wednesday)</b>
<b>Location:</b>	<b>Swantown Marina, OAR boathouse and dock</b>
<b>Content:</b>	Continuation from Day 2
